Our Policy

During the course, we will assess you in different subjects to verify your knowledge and skill development. If necessary, we will create an action plan to help you improve specific areas of learning.

Your assessments will be conducted using a combination of the following methods:

Practical Observations: demonstrate your newly acquired skills through a practical assessment held at the academy. During these assessments, you will be required to bring a model and complete a task within the given time. The assessment criteria will be openly discussed before the examination to ensure students are well-prepared.

Written Assignments & Homework: showcase your theoretical knowledge through research and study. Open-ended questions will be provided for you to complete at home, ensuring you have acquired all the required knowledge before taking the exam.

Multiple-Choice Exams: test your understanding of key theoretical concepts through multiple-choice exams. These assessments are prepared by VTCT and are standardized across all centers. Exams will be conducted at the academy following VTCT assessment guidelines. To pass, you must achieve at least 70% correct answers.

Portfolio of Evidence: throughout the course, you will be required to collect and submit a portfolio of evidence, including:

- •Written assignments
- •Step-by-step procedure records
- •Pictures of your practical work

This portfolio will serve as a record of your progress and demonstrate your competency in each area.

Appeals Procedure (Assessment Dispute)

- 1. Discuss the assessment outcome with your assessor.
- 2. If unresolved, submit an appeal to the internal quality assurer (IQA).
- 3. If the issue remains unresolved, an external appeal can be made to VTCT.

All complaints and appeals must be submitted within 10 working days of the issue arising.

Code od Conduct

As a student of the VTCT Level 3 Diploma in Nail Technology, you are expected to uphold the highest standards of professionalism, respect, and dedication to learning. This includes:

1. Attendance Policy

- Students must maintain a minimum 85% attendance throughout the course. Engaging in learning activities and maintain focus during the lessons is required.
- A minimum of 70% attendance is required to be eligible for exams.
- Punctuality is important! Late arrivals disrupt lessons and may result in being denied entry to class (for example during assessments).
- If a student is unable to attend a session, they must inform the academy in advance and provide valid reasons for their absence.
- Excessive absences may result in disciplinary action or removal from the course.

2. Salon Health & Safety Rules

• Hygiene is crucial: hands must be clean, and nails well-kept before all practical work.

- Workstations must be kept clean and tidy at all times.
- Equipment and tools must be sanitized before and after each use.
- Proper waste disposal must be followed for used materials.
- Any accidents or injuries must be reported to an instructor immediately.

3. Uniform & Professional Appearance

To maintain a professional learning environment, students must adhere to the following uniform guidelines:

- Clothing: Black t-shirt, black trousers, enclosed shoes, and a black apron/tunic.
- Hair: Must be neatly pinned up and kept tidy.
- $\bullet\,$ Jewelry & Accessories: No bracelets, rings, or other jewelry that may interfere with treatments.
- Personal Hygiene: Students must maintain high personal hygiene standards. Clean, well-maintained uniforms must be worn at all times.

4. Practical Lessons & Equipment

• Students will receive a Kit of Products for practical training. This kit can be kept at the academy or taken home but must be brought back on practical days.

- Without the kit, students will not be able to participate in practical sessions.
- All tools and products must be used responsibly and maintained properly.

5. Classroom Etiquette & Learning Environment

- Mobile phones must be switched off or set to silent during lessons.
- Eating and drinking (except water) are not allowed in the classroom or salon area outside consent from teacher/assessor.
- Disruptive behavior, bullying, or discrimination will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action.
 - All assessments must be completed within the given deadlines.

6. Disciplinary Procedures

Failure to comply with the Code of Conduct may result in:

- Verbal or written warnings.
- Temporary suspension from practical sessions.
- Dismissal from the course for repeated or severe misconduct.
